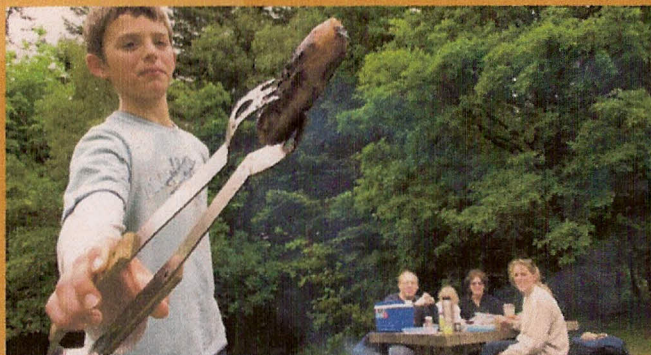

What's included:

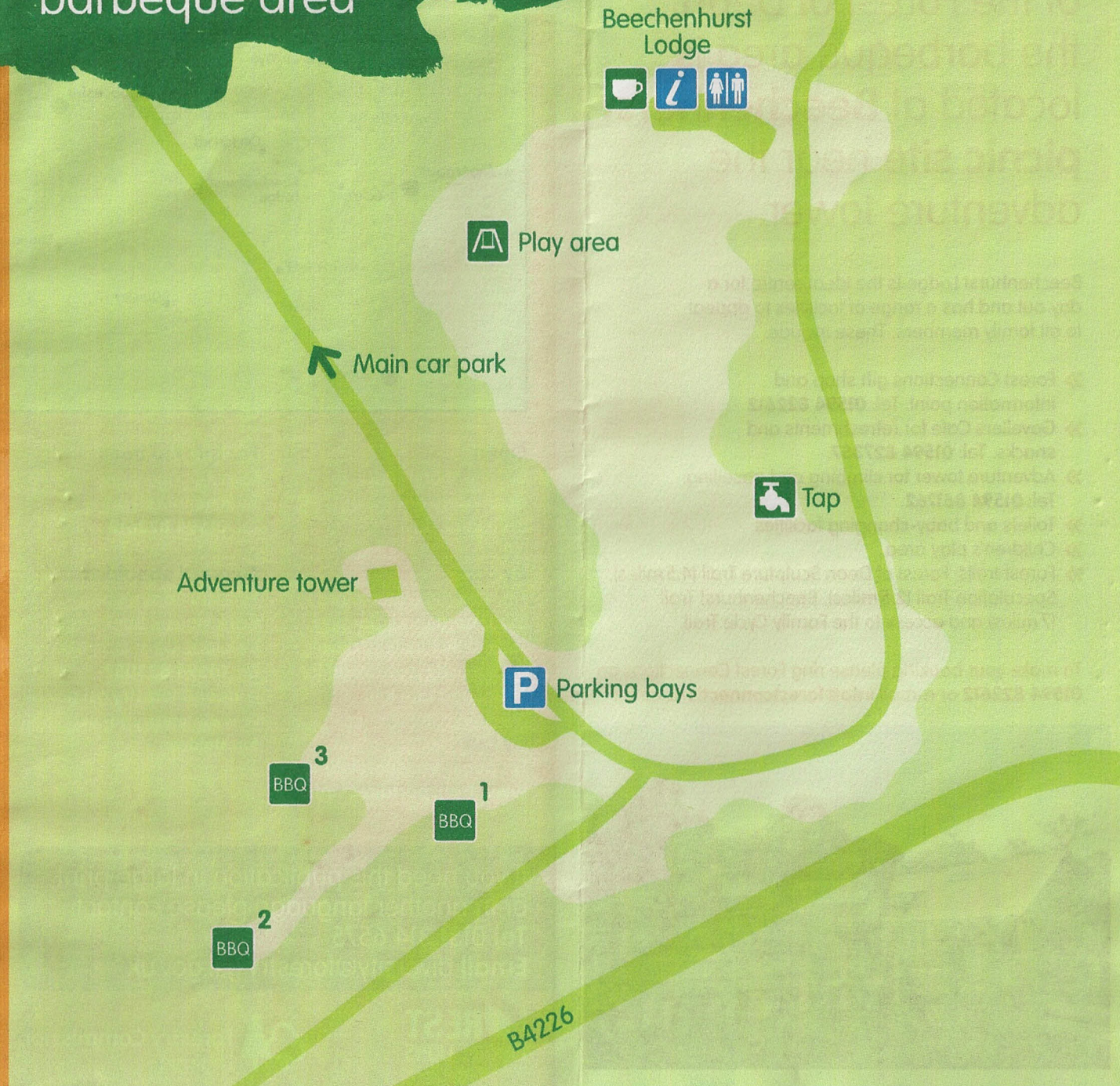
- » One metal barbecue hearth (bring your own charcoal).

Beechenhurst Lodge is the ideal centre for a day out and has a range of facilities to appeal to all family members. These include:

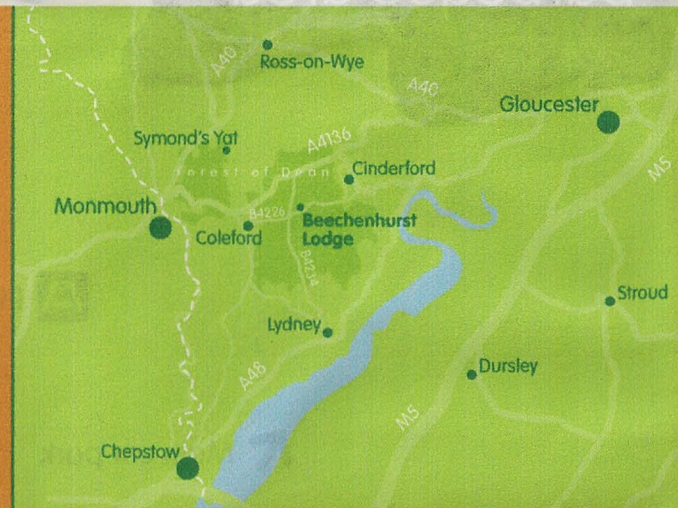
